- a) A By-law to authorize a User Agreement with Club Roma (St. Catharines) Inc. (Three readings – with respect to the use of Hydro Corridor Lands at 149 Vansickle Road. Delegation By-law No. 2004-277, as amended.)
- b) A By-law to authorize a Lease Extension Agreement with St. Catharines Female Hockey Association Inc. (Three readings – with respect to the use of storage space in the Seymour-Hannah Sports & Entertainment Centre at 240 St. Paul Street West. Delegation By-law No. 2004-277, as amended.)
