

The Board of Directors of the Historical Society of St. Catharines would like to respectfully urge the City of St. Catharines to extend regular bus service to the Welland Canals Parkway area, particularly between Queenston St. and Glendale Ave. Many of our members have let us know that it is almost impossible for them to visit the St. Catharines Historical Museum (which is after all a city facility) whenever they wish to attend a meeting, view the exhibits, do research or watch the ships at the viewing station. When the Fallen Workers Memorial is completed later this year, there will be more impetus to visit the museum location.

Now that new subdivisions are being built up along the canal route, there is even more need for bus service to this area.

We sincerely hope that action will soon be taken in this regard.
