Subject: Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

At its meeting of September 18, 2017, the Budget Standing Committee (BSC) asked staff to "... include within the all-encompassing parking plan report information regarding electric car charging stations, including costing."

It is anticipated that the final draft of the Downtown Parking Study will be presented to Council in Q2 of 2018 pending the completion of more comprehensive financial analyses.

In November of 2017, Alectra Utilities Corporation (Alectra) approached the City about entering into a partnership to have Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging stations installed at City Hall for public use. Staff have prepared a report that will be presented at the April 23, 2018 Council meeting seeking Council approval for the Installation of Electric Vehicle Charging stations at the Market Square Parking Lot adjacent to City Hall. The report details the types of EV chargers along with expected costs.
