

## **St. Catharines Transit Commission**

Established in 1961, the St. Catharines Transit Commission is comprised of seven members, two City Councillors and five citizen appointees. All members are appointed by City Council for a four-year term.

The Commission's key responsibilities are as follows;

- Establish Conventional and Paratransit service levels and authorize any increases or decreases to these service levels.
- Establish the Commission's fare structure and approve any changes.
- Submit the annual operating and capital budgets to city council each year.
- Approve contracts and purchases as per the Commission's Purchasing Policy.
- Provide oversight to the General Manager.

Meeting are held on the fourth Thursday of each month at 4:30 pm. July and August meetings are at the call of the Chair. Meetings take place at the Commission offices at 2012 First Street Louth in St. Catharines. The Transit Commission is a voluntary position with no remuneration.
