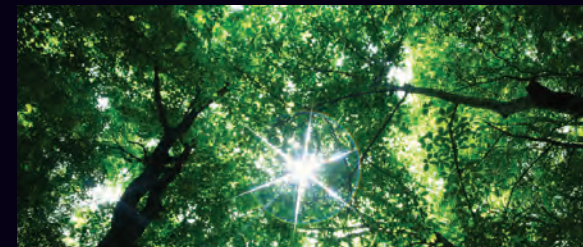

Niagara Region Environmental Awards 2013

The 24th annual Environmental Awards will honour individuals, businesses, community groups, youth and schools for their initiatives towards safeguarding Niagara's natural environment.

The Niagara Region encourages all its residents to identify and nominate family, neighbours, businesses, non-profits, community groups, schools and young achievers who have made significant contributions to maintaining and restoring environmental quality in Niagara.

Eligibility Criteria

All residents of Niagara are eligible to apply. A nominee must have made significant contributions within the territorial boundaries of Niagara region such as:

- Taking steps to protect the existing environment
- Restoring environment quality
- Increasing public awareness and understanding

The nomination may recognize a long-term ongoing contribution over several years involving different activities. Alternatively, it might be based on a single important achievement or initiative.

Award Categories

Awards will be presented in the categories listed below:

- 1. Lifetime Achievement Award** – This award will honour an individual who has made a substantial contribution to environment conservation in Niagara over a period of many years.
- 2. Green Non-profit Award** – This award will recognize a government agency, institution or non-profit organization for its contribution to maintaining a healthy environment.
- 3. Green Business Award** – This award honours a business for its contribution to environmental quality in Niagara. This category includes farms and agri-businesses.
- 4. Green Family Award** – This award will recognize a family for outstanding achievement in reducing its environmental footprint.
- 5. Volunteer Award** – This award will recognize an individual or a community group's contribution to a cleaner, greener Niagara.
- 6. Young People's Award, Elementary Age Category** – This award will recognize the contributions of children in the age group 6 – 13 years.
- 7. Young People's Award, Secondary Age Category** – This award will recognize the contributions of young people in the age group 14 – 18 years.



The Awards Process

The nominations will be reviewed by a special selection committee.

The awards will be presented in June.
