Your Worship and Members of Council:

As you are aware, the Niagara Regional Police Service has made a recommendation to the Niagara Police Services Board concerning the location of the new #1 District police facility to serve the residents of St. Catharines and Thorold. The Board, while considering this recommendation, has sought input from you and we understand that your Council will further consider this matter during the Council meeting to be held on Monday May 13, 2013.

We recognize that the location of a police facility within a community is a matter of significant importance to the residents. We are aware that, as Council considers this matter, it is quite likely that there will be area residents who have questions regarding the impact that a police facility may have on their neighbourhood. Given the locations under consideration, this may be of special importance to St. Patricks' Ward Councillors Mathew Siscoe and Mark Elliott.

Deputy Chief Joe Matthews will be present at your Council meeting on May 13, 2013 and will be pleased, subject to the discretion of Council, to respond to any questions or concerns that may be posed by concerned citizens. Specifically, Deputy Chief Matthews will be able to address issues relating to the nature of police operations that will take place at the new #1 District facility as well as general design concepts.


