Reconstruction of Regional Road 38 (Martindale Road)  
Between Elderwood Drive and the Q.E.W.  
City of St. Catharines**

Niagara Region (the Region) has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for the reconstruction of Regional Road 38 (Martindale Road) between Elderwood Drive and the Q.E.W., in the City of St. Catharines.

**Key Elements of the Recommended Design**

The study recommends:

- a three lane cross section from Erion Road southerly to Elderwood Drive. It consists of two 3.5 m lanes with a 4.0 m center left turn lane. A 1.5 m bike lane is proposed for each direction.
- a four lane cross section from North Service Road southerly to Erion Road. It consists of two 3.5 m lanes and a 1.5 m bike lane in each direction as well as auxiliary turning lanes.
- urban cross section throughout, with curb and gutter and concrete sidewalks along both sides of the road.
- streetscaping along Martindale Road including planting of trees and shrubs, where appropriate.

**The Process**

The study was completed in compliance with Schedule 'C' of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007 & 2011), which is approved under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*. Public and review agency consultation is a key element of the Class EA process and input will be sought from various parties throughout this study.

**Environmental Study Report (ESR)**

An ESR has been prepared to document the planning and decision making process. The results of the study will be available for review for 30 calendar days starting May 15, 2013 and ending June 14, 2013. It is available for review at the following locations:
